



Aerial Operations



Course Description

This course is designed to provide the knowledge and skills necessary to operate a fire department aerial ladder truck and associated equipment. Students will learn to safely and effectively operate an aerial ladder at a fire or emergency scene. Major topics covered in the course are truck company operations, tool requirements, terminology, techniques of spotting, stabilizing, working angles, loading, extreme operating conditions, raising and lowering, controls and valves, hydraulic systems, water tower operations, stand-pipe operations, ladders, safety rules, maintenance, and testing.

Certification Information

The Fire Apparatus Driver/Operator Aerial certification exam is not offered during the duration of the course. Certification information can be found under the certification portion of the web-page.
